In English, we have been analysing texts looking to identify the common features of biographies and autobiographies. We have also reviewed our understanding of different types of sentences and revisited using inverted commas. On Friday we wrote a short, 50 word, autobiographical account.

We have finished our unit of learning on the place value of numbers. We completed this learning by learning about negative numbers and Roman numerals.
