

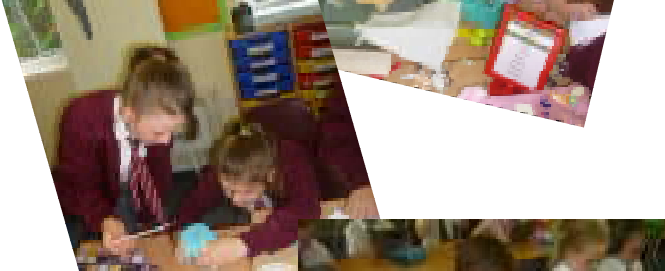
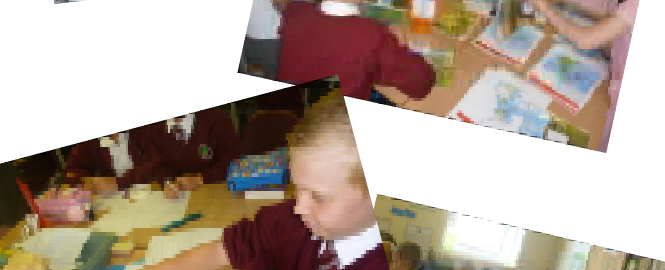
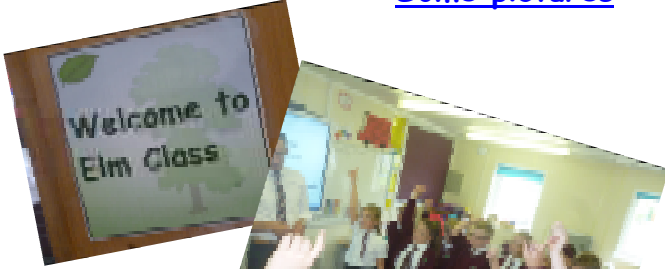

These last few days have been a time to get to know each other and our new classroom. But this hasn't stopped us from learning.

In Maths this week we have reviewed our understanding of place value and extended the size of the numbers we can read, write and order. We have gone up to 1 million!

We've had an interesting time in English. We have been developing story telling skills by creating story maps and using them to help us remember. We have also looked at report writing. We have focused on the structure and features and written a report based on the story we have learned to tell.

For Geography we learned about National Parks. We thought about why they are called 'breathing spaces' and why we have them.

We started with a bang in Science. Not literally, but we went straight into testing materials for their properties. We tested for hardness, absorbency and electrical conductivity.
