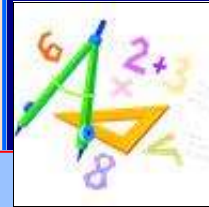

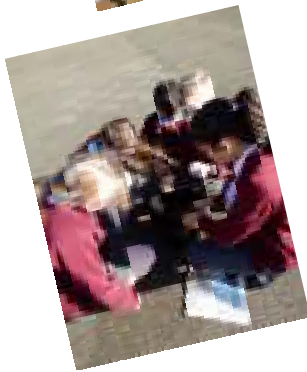

This Week...

This week we have been visited by Macbeth and Lady Macbeth. The children interviewed the two characters to try and get answers to questions they had prepared. This helped the children to understand the thoughts, feelings and actions of the two characters. We then used this understanding to write a portrait of the character.

In Maths we have continued with fractions. We have looked at equivalent fractions, comparing fractions and adding fractions. We have been also learning how to use the vocabulary of fractions.

Science this week was all about lifecycles. While previously we have focused on plants we have now moved onto animals, namely insects and amphibians. After clearing up our ideas about these animals we went on to explore the lifecycles of a frog, butterfly and dragonfly. We compared the lifecycles and learned about metamorphosis.

In geography we drew the journey of a river and learned the names for different parts of a river. We also have started to create a river jigsaw by copying a map grid square noting all the features in that square.
