We have returned to a normal routine.

In English we have really enjoyed learning about Macbeth. After watching the play we have spent some time sequencing the main events in the story. We have explored the characters of Macbeth and Lady Macbeth trying to work out what their personalities are and why they behave as they do.

During Maths we have come to end of our focus on fractions. We have reviewed our learning so far but also focused on adding and subtracting fractions. We have also done some real world problem solving.

In Music this week we learned about the science of sound. We played with different ways of making sound, considered how the sound travels and why we hear the sounds we hear.

While some went to Cobham to represent the school in a Rugby tournament the rest of us learned about 'abstraction' and wrote some code to instruct the computer to play a tune.

In Gym we continued to learn about performing a sequence with a partner while exchanging a small piece of apparatus e.g a ball or hoop.
