


YEAR 5 LEARNING

In English this week we have focused on re-drafting chapter one of our stories, that we wrote before half term. We can now add improved vocabulary, adverbials and relative clauses so that the pictures we create are more complete. We have also started to learn about 'flashbacks'. We watched clips from films and read parts of Harry Potter to identify how and why flashbacks can be used. We will be adding a flashback to our stories later.

During Maths we have learned how to use a protractor to measure angles. We have named angles, drawn angles and calculated missing angles on a straight line, around a point and within triangles.

In P.E, this week, we enjoyed skipping followed by a session to develop our overarm throwing technique. We threw balls, beanbags, javelins and vortex rockets. In Dance we extended our space theme dance. Last time we built a rocket and this week we trained to be astronauts and took off.
