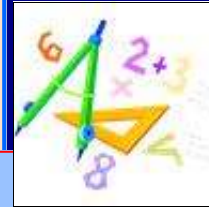

This Week...

In English we have explored how changing the 'voice' of a poem can change the meaning and feeling of a poem. We have also learned about contractions, noting where the apostrophe is positioned. In addition, we have written a new verse for a poem trying to replicate the style of the poem and then consider how we will perform it.

During Maths we have shown great enthusiasm when learning about fractions. We have ordered fractions with different denominators. We have calculated equivalent and simplified fractions and we finished the week by comparing fractions, decimals and percentages.

In RE we have started to learn about Islam. We learned a little about the religion around the world and Allah (PBUH). We made a 'thank you' card but we couldn't use any representative art.

In Science we focused on the different parts of a flower and their role in reproduction. We practised drawing and labelling a scientific diagram.
