

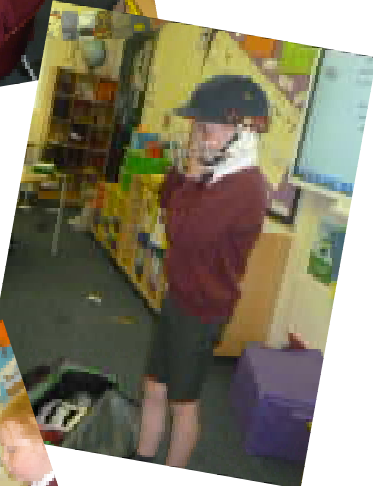
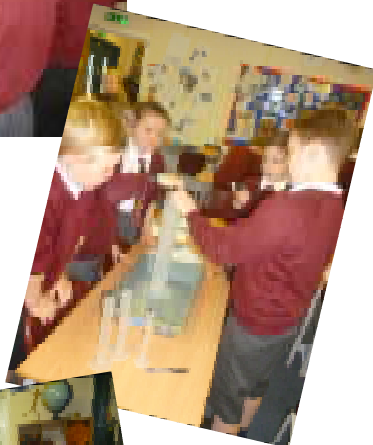

In maths this week we have focused on angles. We have learned about different types and tried to master the use of a protractor to measure angles.

In English we have spent time looking at the first two chapters of *Carrie's War*. We have read about evacuation and accounts from evacuees.
