In English we have been reading poems of different kinds trying to find a poem that we like. We have then changed the subject of the poem but kept the style of the poem. We have then practised and rehearsed performing these poems for our 'SLAM' competition.

During Maths we have continued excellent progress with fractions. We confidently simplify fractions. We have learned how to equate fractions, decimals and percentages and calculate fractional amounts of quantities.

In Geography, with Mrs Brown, we used the internet to find weather data for Addlestone. We compared the temperatures and rainfall with UK data and made some comparisons and conclusions about our weather. We also drew line graphs to represent the data.
