In English this week we have proof-read, edited and polished our *Coraline* diaries. We have written a playscript—adapting an exciting part of the story using playscript features - focusing on the present tense. We have also looked at the features of letters and started to write a letter from *Coraline* to her 'real' parents.

In Maths we have focused on place value and changing numbers by multiplying or dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We have also been rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000.

In Science this week we investigated dissolving. We designed a fair test to find out which materials are soluble or not.

We had an exciting time in Computing, writing code for a simple driving game. We had to assign values to variables and use conditional statements. Our computational thinking was stretched.

In Art this week we continued to look at 'proportion' when drawing people. We added watercolour to our figures. Finally we tried to use different techniques to show movement.
