

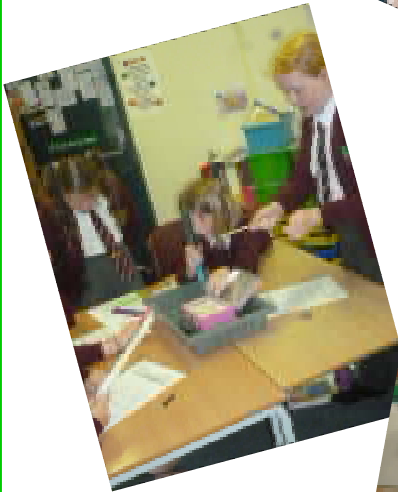
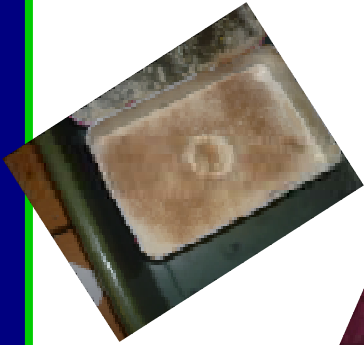

This Week...

In English we have been trying to write poems using expanded noun phrases with powerful vocabulary. We have also learned about ways to remember tricky spellings and about using the present and past progressive tense. All these new terms!

In Maths we have started a unit on decimals. We have focused on understanding place value.

In Science we learned about the force of gravity. We learned that a force is a push or a pull and that it is invisible. We can only learn about it by observing the effects so we dropped objects into a bed of flour and then measured the craters. We made conclusions about the size, shape and weight of a dropped object and the crater it forms.

In Computing we continued learning about e-safety and focused on Search Engines and how to evaluate a website.
