This Week...

In English we have been writing an eyewitness recount of when a spaceship flew over our school. We have focused on using the features of a recount, writing complex sentences, using the coordinating conjunction 'nor' and writing lists. After the first draft we have worked with a partner to proofread and edit the recount considering the purpose and audience. Next week, we will start to look into persuasion.

Maths has involved multiplication and division. We have found prime factors using factor trees. We then used shortened notation. Later in the week we returned to multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 and then by multiples of 10 and 100. Next week, we will be exploring formal multiplication.

In Geography, we learned about tectonic plates and how 'fold' mountains are formed. We used atlases to locate the major mountain ranges in the world. Next, we will be learning about Mallory.

In Science, we learned about the discoveries of Copernicus and Galileo. We used an app on the iPad to present information about these scientists.
