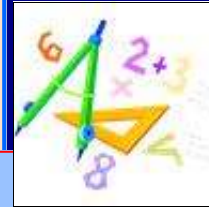

On Monday we had an exciting time learning about Spain and the language. We made and tasted Potato Bravas (Mmmm!). We studied the art of Picasso and Gaudi and tried to reproduce our own. We drew maps, marking on physical features and... we made lollypop puppets in traditional costume and wrote a small script in Spanish including greetings and simple conversation questions. Finally, we made a sombrero from newspapers. A very creative start to the week.

In English, we again focused on the thoughts of Coraline and wrote a letter that tried to express her feelings. Later in the week we interpreted a description by drawing a creature from the book.

In Maths we have focused upon the skill of rounding as a way to help make calculations easier and quicker. We have rounded to the nearest multiple of 10, 100 and 1000.

In Science this week we learned how to separate mixtures of soluble and insoluble materials. We used sieves, filters and evaporation.
