In science we have been looking at how our pulse rate changes. We used stethoscopes to listen to each others heart beats and learnt how to check our pulse rates. We tried to investigate how quickly our pulse rates return to resting rates after exercise but discovered that our results were not as we expected. The conclusion we drew was that we were not very good at measuring our pulses.
