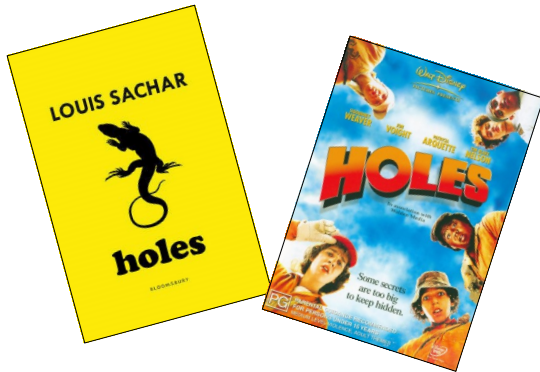


YEAR 6 LEARNING NEWS
