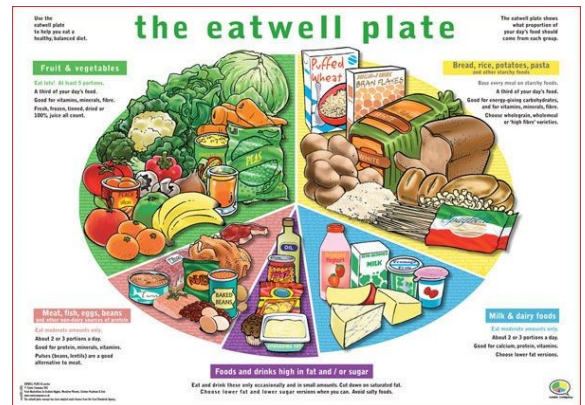
Well done to Gray and Hattie who represented Ongar Place at a Dance workshop for Synergy Dance. They had to perform and demonstrate to 50 teachers!
