

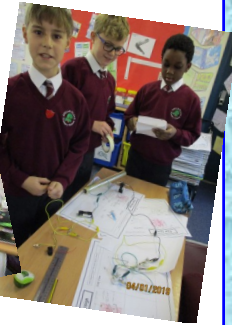
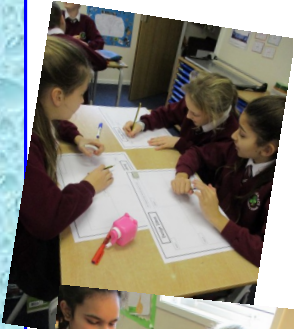
# YEAR 6 LEARNING NEWS

## Learning Highlights

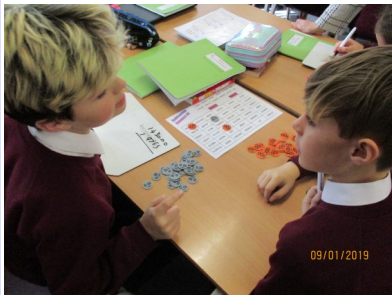
HAPPY NEW YEAR!
