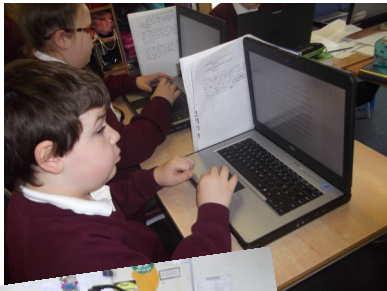


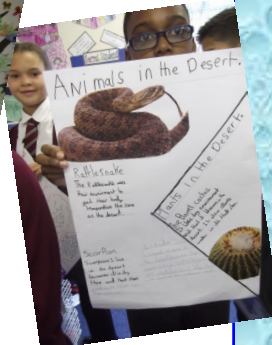
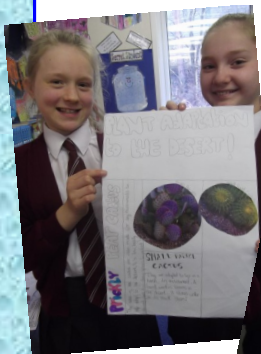
Learning Highlights
