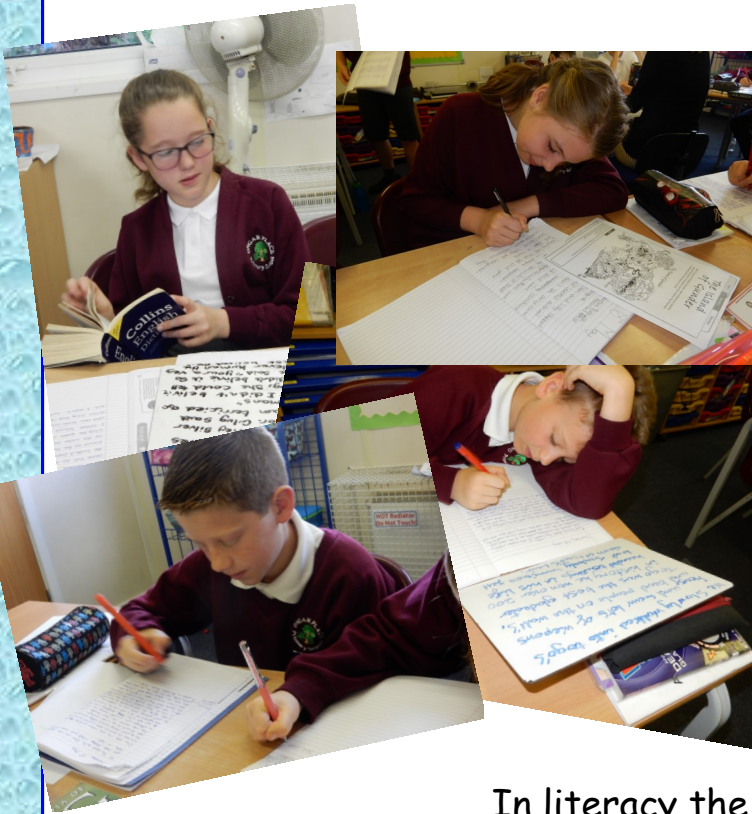


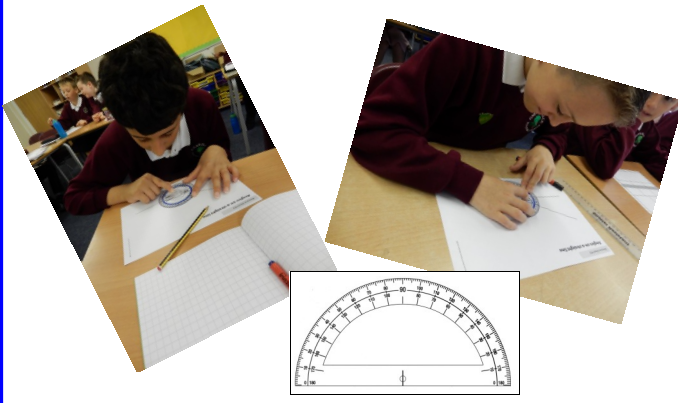
Learning Highlights
