With only 2 weeks until SATs we have been having one last practice of past papers. Yet again the children have taken things in their stride and done really well.

In our literacy we have continued to look at poetry linked to animal cruelty. The children have read a poem called 'The Dancing Bear' and been looking at images of bears in captivity. This has generated some fabulous debate and we have developed a great list of powerful vocabulary and phrases that they will be using in their own poetry.



As part of our Geography work this term we have been finding out what life is like in Iceland. The children have been using atlases and the internet to compare Iceland with the UK. We will be investigating the effects of the volcanoes in Iceland on daily life and the impact on the wider world.
