

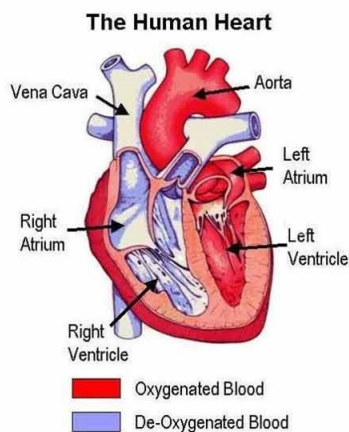
Learning Highlights
