Monday was a Day of Languages. In year 6 we learnt about the language and culture of Italy. During the day the children learnt about Italian landmarks and worked in small groups to

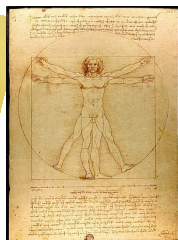


research and prepare posters about them. We also designed and coloured some Venetian Mardi Gras masks and
