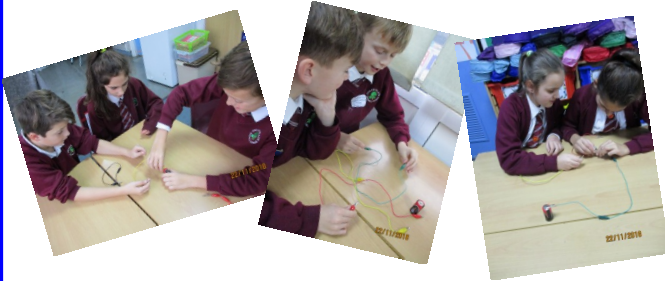


Learning Highlights
