This week the children have become amazing writers, some even making their own books. There have been a lot of hands-on activities and glitter has been everywhere, but it's all resulted in amazing learning!

We've been retelling stories to each other, remembering the importance of exciting story language and that we must include a beginning, middle and end. We made up our own stories, shared our favourites, and retold Hansel and Gretel using our own words. Mrs MacCormack was amazed with our writing stamina!

In maths and numeracy we have been problem solving: looking at number sequences and missing numbers. We have been writing numbers in glitter, hanging out the number clothes on the washing line, and making number words with Playdough - we loved that part.

We have also spent some time this week investigating bubbles. First we looked at the characteristics of bubbles: in particular their different sizes and how delicate they are. Then we realised that we all have our own personal bubbles (or some of us like to call these spaceships!) and that these are different sizes for different people we are close to. And we now know how to be careful when getting close to each other's bubbles.
