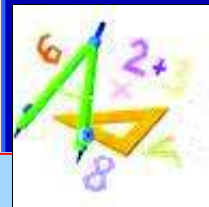

In English we have explored letter writing and the use of adjectives. We have written letters from Coraline to her 'real' mother trying to express the thoughts and feelings of Coraline. We have also been developing our use of descriptive language by using adjectives and adverbs.

In Maths we have used numberlines to compare numbers. We focused on decimals and very large numbers. We have also practised the 4X table.
